# LOCATION

Alexandria is located at the western edge of the Nile Delta between the Mediterranean Sea and Lake Mariout. In terms of its importance, it is the second city in the Arab Republic of Egypt and its main port. More than three quarters of the country's foreign trade passes through it. The second part is in the western port separated by a peninsula in the shape of the letter T. The first part is devoted to general merchandise and the second part is for timber and casting trade. The eastern port is shallow and is not used in navigation, while the western port actually constitutes what was termed the Alexandria port. The port limits the imaginary line connecting its two ends. External breakwaters.

### PILOTAGE

The port provides pilotage service using the service launch or the water taxi boat to receive the yachts arriving at the port to guide them to the berths and provide assistance in mooring on the mooring buoys or on the various berths, including the customs berths.

#### NAVIGATIONAL AIDS

## CHARACTERISTICS OF SHIPPING SEA BERTHS (OFF-SHORE) AND SUPPLY LINES:

The sizes and tonnages of vessels calling at the port, their frequency rate, and the duration of stay at the berths: Vessels of (35,000 ton - 45,000 ton) = 10-14 vessel/year. Vessels of (20,000 ton - 35,000 ton) = 12-15 vessel/year.

- Y1 Buoy Reef Defender; which is a yellow-painted cylindrical buoy 180 cm in length and 120 cm in diameter, topped by a cylindrical metal tower equipped with a radar reflector with a range of 2 nautical miles and intermittent yellow lighting.
- Y2 Buoy Reef Defender, a yellow-painted cylindrical buoy 180 cm in length and 120 cm in diameter, topped by a cylindrical metal tower equipped with a radar reflector with a range of 2 nautical miles, and intermittent yellow lighting.
- Mooring approach buoy; which is a cylindrical buoy with a diameter of 5 meters and a height of 2.5 meters.
